

UP 2413 – Landmark Apartments – IMPORTANT NOTICE

Dear Residents

Investigations into a recent kitchen fire in a Blackall Street apartment indicates that the originally installed dishwasher was the cause.

These dishwashers were subject to a 2004 safety recall which many people may not have been aware of.

282 of these dishwashers were installed in Landmark during construction, as private appliances do not form part of the common property we are unaware when these appliances are replaced or upgraded.

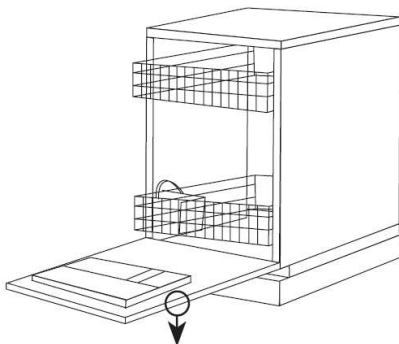
We do not know how many of these original appliances are still in use in Landmark.

We have been in contact with the safety recall department of Omega and Smeg in anticipation of multiple recall services being required. As these are older parts and need to be sourced they have requested we conduct a count of remaining dishwashers so that recall parts can be pre-ordered.

We ask all residents that have an original dishwasher still in place to please check your appliance serial number and report to Raine & Horne if yours is an affected model.

Find the Serial Number - Omega and Smeg Dishwashers

The 9-digit serial number is located on the inside edge of the dishwasher door on the right hand side (appearing after the letters SER).



SERIAL & MODEL NUMBERS

Affected dishwashers were manufactured between November 1998 and May 2003 and have a 9-digit serial number ending in 0, 1, 2, 3, 8 or 9.

Some of these dishwashers were sold after May 2003.
